Free Professionals Awareness Raising Training

These funded training sessions have been developed to provide an awareness and understanding of the day-to-day challenges of living with Neurodevelopmental Conditions (NDCs) and the surrounding issues for staff working in Warrington to support children, young people and families.

Our full-day awareness raising training enables professionals to:

- Understand the difference and similarities between ADHD, ASD/C, and other NDCs.
- Recognise the typical behaviours of ADHD, ASD/C and other NDCs
- Recognise the impact that unsupported and unmanaged characteristics of NDCs can have on an individual and their family.
- Understand the impact that sensory processing difficulties have on children and young people.
- Recognise local support available for professionals, young people and families who have children with NDCs
